The Quietest Tear

There is a special tear that falls. Its rarity is also its significance. It is the quietest tear.

It only falls from eyes that have seen something breathtaking and profound. You might never know that the quietest tear is on its way. The face is empty of any emotion and there's no expression to signal its arrival. But the mind is clear and the heart is soft, tender and more open than it ever has been before.

The quietest tear bears little resemblance to the heaving, messy cries of regret or the burning, salty tears of betrayal and disappointment. In all likelihood, these noisy impostors have come and gone in recent days that seemed like weeks or months or years. The weight of the world was just dumped on young delicate shoulders. And that slow passage of days seems to have made everyone older and wiser in a surreal and unwelcome way. But this was just the preview.

Her gaze turns downward - ashamed that she could have ever considered taking the life of her child. And just as the quietest tear starts to fall to the floor, she looks up again - in awe of a life so precious that each of his days were written down before one of them came to pass. Then with a swipe of the hand, it's over. And a tear-stained face becomes flush and warmed with God-inspired love and hope for the days to come.

There is a special tear that falls every day at The Alpha Center. But we never grow weary of its significance. Because with every quiet tear comes a saved life and a changed life. We thank God for this awesome privilege, and we thank you for all the tears you've made possible. Please pray for us daily and give as you feel led.

Fleet for Little Feet saves baby at LifeLight!



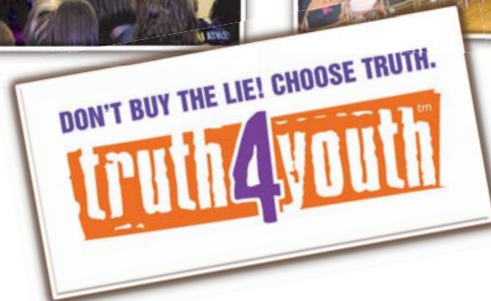
